- Successfully implemented a new discharge planning program that reduced hospital readmissions by 23%.
- Successfully advocated for increased funding for mental health services in the community, which resulted in an additional \$1 million being allocated to these services.
- Successfully managed a caseload of 60 clients with diverse diagnoses while maintaining high standards of care.
- Regularly provided crisis intervention counselling to individuals experiencing psychiatric emergencies, which averted unnecessary hospitalizations on 12 occasions.
